

Deb Drumond – Explorations in Collage Workshop

MATERIALS LIST – not all required but this is to give you an idea of good resources for collage.

Small scissor and/or exacto knife

Backer board for cutting-(thicker cardboard like from backs of pads of paper)

Substrate to collage on– Bristol or other cardstock or small panels, watercolor or multi-media papers.

Papers:

Colored, Pre-printed or decorative papers: such as printed tissue, wrapping paper, raid your recycle bin, magazine pages, colorful scraps, even fabric and ribbon, construction or Canson, old artwork to repurpose magazine pages, an interesting scraps, book pages, etc.

An assortment acrylic (or acrylic “gouache”) paints for making painted papers

A couple of brushes for spreading color . (1” flat brushes as an example.)

Vellum or tissue or rice papers

Pad of drawing/sketch paper 11x14 or so.

Perm Markers (sharpies) and acrylic (such as Posca or similar)

Graphite stick or pencils

Stamps and inks

Tissue or rice papers.

Glue – matte medium (golden, Utrecht or other similar brand) or Lineco. OR glue sticks if you prefer

Glue applicator – old credit card, small brush or silicone applicator

Artist or painter tape

Paper towels

(optional) Spray bottle
