

HALEY HASLER Supply List for Oil Painting: Self Portrait with Still Life

OIL PAINT:

A primary-color oil palette including red, yellow, blue, and white. 37 ml or larger.

I use Gambin; other brands are acceptable. Choose one red, one yellow, one blue from the list:

Hansa Yellow Light or Medium, Cadmium Yellow Light or Medium

Naphthol Red Light or Medium, Cadmium Red Light or Medium

Ultramarine Blue, Pthalo Blue

Titanium/Zinc White

BRUSHES: Bristle and soft-hair in a range of sizes (I prefer Silver hog bristle filberts sizes 8,10, 12, 14 and Winsor Newton Monarch filberts 6,8,10; other brands are acceptable.)

PAINTING MEDIUM: Galkyd Lite

PAINT THINNER: Gamsol

PALETTE: A large glass palette is preferable. Disposable paper palette 9x12 or larger can be used.

PAINTING KNIFE: with tapered tip

CANVAS: 18x 24 cotton or linen stretched canvas. Better-quality oil-primed or double -primed acrylic canvas is much nicer to work with.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS: one small jar and one big jar, rags, ivory soap for cleaning brushes

RECOMMENDED FURNITURE: easel, table for palette, clamp light, table for still life, medium-sized mirror
